



HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

At Wolverdene School, we recognise each child as an individual, and aim to give all children every opportunity to realise their full potential. We believe that a firm partnership between the school, parents/carers and the child is essential if we are to achieve this aim. We therefore ask all parents/carers and children to enter into our Home/School Agreement.

The Responsibilities of Wolverdene School

At Wolverdene we will:

- provide a secure, happy and stimulating learning environment within a positive ethos of social and emotional learning
- provide a broad and balanced curriculum which challenges your child to reach their potential and fulfils the requirements of the National Curriculum
- encourage your child to keep our school rules
- actively discourage all forms of bullying and discrimination and respond quickly to any bullying issues
- keep you informed about what we aim to teach your child
- give you regular information about your child's progress, including an annual written report and invite you to the annual review of the statement
- set appropriate homework for your child
- make you feel welcome whenever you visit the school
- respond to your questions, concerns or complaints as quickly as possible

The Responsibilities of the parents/carers

All parents/carers will:

- accept the School's aims and objectives and positively support the school
- ensure that your child attends school punctually every day during term time, unless there is a good reason for absence (e.g. illness)
- be responsible for transporting your child in the event that transport is refused.
- notify the school by letter or telephone in the event of absence
- support the school dress code as shown in the prospectus
- attend parent/teacher meetings and the annual review of the statement to discuss your child's progress
- support your child with homework that is set, including reading.
- support the school's behaviour policy
- keep us informed of where to contact you in an emergency
- promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect your child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school
- sign your child's home/school book weekly to show it has been read

The responsibility of the child

- work hard and concentrate fully in my lessons
- behave well at all times and keep the school rules
- be honest
- complete my homework (including reading) on time
- remember to bring my kit and home school book
