

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 and is allocated to schools to work with pupils who have been registered for free school meals (FSM) at any point in the last six years (known as 'Ever 6 FSM').

Schools also receive funding for children who have been looked after continuously for more than six months, and children of service personnel.

We have used our funding for year 13/14 (£25484) for the following:

- Staff training and pupil progress tracking systems.
- 1 to 1 teaching with a member of the school team
- Staff training on Nurture Group
- Training and setting up of social skills groups
- ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support) or extra pastoral support.
- Dance, Movement and Occupational Therapist
- Psychotherapist

Our plan for year 14/15 expenditure of £36,600

- 1 to 1 teaching with a member of the school team.
- Small group support from a member of our Assessment and Reintegration Team (ART)
- Small group support from the Nurture Group.
- ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support) or extra pastoral support.
- Dance, Movement and Occupational Therapist
- Psychotherapist
